As you are surely aware, graffiti is an artform that started with highly stylized writing on walls using spray paint and such, and here we are introducing a hand lettering font with a graffiti-like appearance. Once you get used to this style of writing, break the mold and add your own personal touches for even more enjoyment! Give it some edge like you would feel when skateboarding and listening to hip-hop or punk rock. We recommend writing with a chisel tip marker.

How to Write Hand Lettering Font Vol. 4

1. The letters lean slightly to the left.



2. A sense of visual rhythm is more important than legibility, and the momentum of the lines and the speed of the strokes are also important.



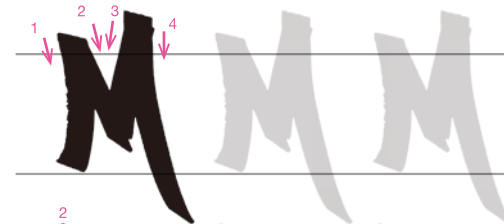
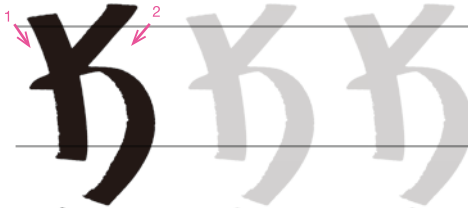
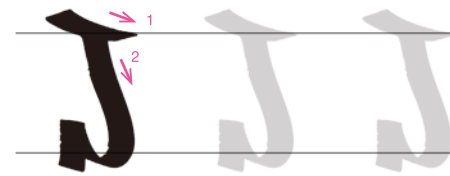
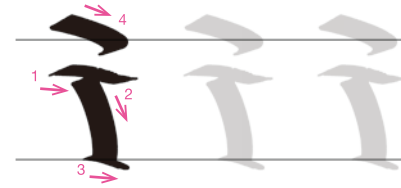
3. Keep in mind that the difference in thickness of the horizontal and vertical dimensions of the tip of the pen can be used effectively.

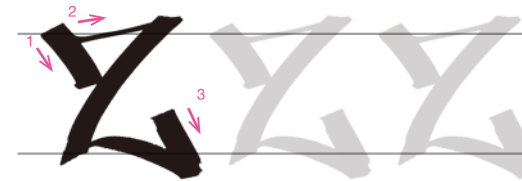
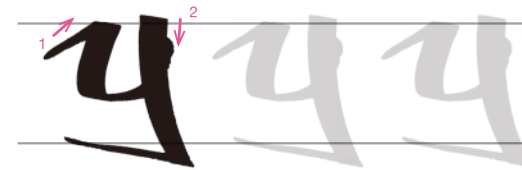
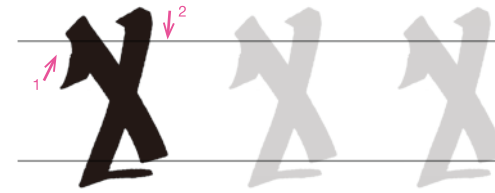


4. The graffiti-esque look in which you can't decipher what is written at first glance is what makes this lettering cool.
